

STANTON COMMUNITY SCHOOLS FOUNDATION SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship will be awarded annually to four graduating seniors (two males, two females) in the amount of \$200.00 per scholarship payable directly to the student.

SELECTION COMMITTEE & CRITERIA

The Stanton Community Schools Foundation governs the award. The award committee consists of two board members of the SCS foundation in conjunction with the High School Counselor. The Committees recommendations are approved by the full board of directors of the SCS Foundation before awarded.

The selection committee may give extra consideration to students who have participated in multiple school-sponsored activities.

APPLICATION

The school shall notify seniors of this scholarship and distribute applications to interested students on or before March 14th. Applications are to be completed in full and submitted to the Guidance Counselor on or before April 18, 2008.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

- 1) The student must be a graduating senior of the Stanton Community Schools.
- 2) The student must have a minimum overall Grade Point Average of 2.5/4.0 at the end of the 7th semester of his or her high school studies.
- 3) The student must attend an accredited college, community college, or vocational school the next term following graduation from high school.
- 4) The student must have participated & committed to any one school sponsored activity for all four years.
- 5) The student must submit an application to the Guidance Counselor on or before April 18th.

PAYMENT

A check of \$200.00 will be issued directly to the student upon verification that the student is attending class for the second semester and has successfully completed at least 12 College Credit hours during the previous semester. Proof of attendance & verification of 12 successfully completed college credit hours may be mailed to Stanton Community Schools Foundation, PO Box 749, Stanton NE 68779 by **February 1, 2009**.

LOSS OF SCHOLARSHIP

The student may lose the scholarship for intentionally falsifying information on the scholarship application or failing to meet the requirements stated in the payment section above. If the scholarship is lost no alternate scholarship will be awarded for the academic year.
