A regular meeting of the Stanton Community Schools Board of Education was convened in open and public session on Monday, October 9, 2006 at 3:00 p.m. in the High/Middle School Library, at the Stanton Community High School, 1007 Kingwood, Stanton, Nebraska. The roll was called by President Brad Johnson and the following Board members were present: Michael Marotz, Brad Johnson, Carey Tejkl, John Mandl, and Brian Nordby. Absent: Al Wolverton. Also present were Michael Sieh, Chris Stogdill, Mary McKeon, Kim Hoehne and one guest.

President Brad Johnson announced the location and informed the public of the current copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the Library meeting room.

Motion was made by Carey Tejkl, seconded by Brian Nordby to declare the meeting open and properly advertised by advance notice in the Stanton Register. Notice of the meeting was given in advance by publication in accordance with the Board approve method for giving notice of meetings. Notice of this meeting was given in advance to the president of the board and all members prior to the meeting date. AMPVF-MC.

Al Wolverton joined the meeting at 3:02 p.m.

Motion was made by John Mandl, seconded by Brian Nordby to approve the board agenda as provided. AMPVF-MC.

Minutes from the September 11th hearing to exceed growth rate, budget hearing, tax request hearing and regular meeting were approved and accepted by the president.

A public forum was held. One guest was welcomed and communications were read.

Elementary Principal Mary McKeon reported on parent/teacher conferences, parent involvement conference, appreciation supper and pep rally, Industrial

Technology curriculum, Peer review, STARS update, end of first quarter, ILCD update, and elementary leadership conference.

Secondary Principal/Activity Director Chris Stogdill reported on technology plan, Schoolmaster training, teacher appreciation week, district contests, and all state music.

Superintendent Sieh gave the annual report for the budget finance & grants committee. He also reported on the elementary heating and air conditioning project, stage lighting, dedication, building security, grants and board policies.

Motion was made by John Mandl seconded by Al Wolverton to approve the industrial technology curriculum. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Al Wolverton seconded by Brad Johnson, to recognize the contributions made in memory of Scott Weatherholt (past board member) towards the activity complex. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Brian Nordby, seconded by Carey Tejkl to approve the budget, finance, & grants school improvement action plan. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Michael Marotz, seconded by John Mandl to a) approve payment for the September bills of District #3 presented at this meeting; b) accept the Activity Account Reports; c) accept the Treasurer's Report; d) accept the Board Summary Report; e) accept the Statement of Revenue and f) approve the cooperative fund report. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Al Wolverton, seconded by John Mandl that the Board holds a closed session at 4:15 p.m. for personnel and the evaluation of job performance clearly necessary for the protection of the public interest or for the prevention of needless injury to the reputation of an individual in compliance with the law. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Al Wolverton, seconded by John Mandl to reconvene in open session at 4:55 p.m. before any formal action was taken. AMPVF-MC.

The meeting was duly adjourned at 4:56 p.m. (corrected)
